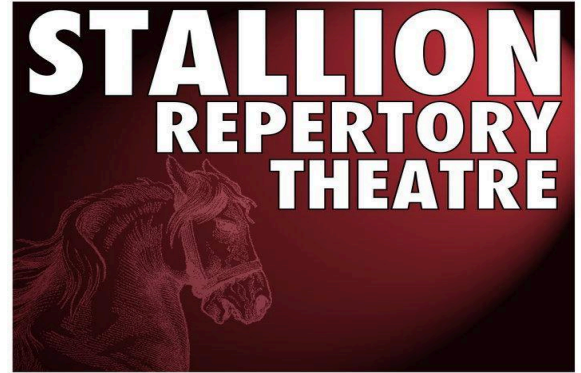


Code of Conduct and Policies



All students of The Stallion Repertory Theatre agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct and Policies:

Code of Conduct

- Please honor the commitments that you have made to this theatre.
- Be on time and call the stage manager if you are late or unable to make it.
- Do not direct your fellow actors or crew. If you have an idea, please bring it to the directors privately (at an appropriate time).
- Be respectful of the teachers, directors, classmates, and other volunteers of this theatre. No bullying or disrespect will be tolerated.
- Be respectful of the theatre. Please help keep the theatre's appearance clean and professional.
- Please keep a professional image when representing The Stallion Rep and SPHS.
- Students must maintain a "C" average in all classes in order to be cast in any after school productions.

Policies

- Alcohol and illegal drugs are not allowed for any member of this acting troupe. Any member who is caught breaking this rule, or is subject to disciplinary action from SPHS and/or law enforcement will be promptly removed.
- No pranks will be permitted during any performance. This includes closing night pranks.
- Please take care of all props/set items. Remember that some are borrowed and are not replaceable.
- Do not move anyone's prop without their knowledge and consent.
- Only props are to be placed on prop tables. No personal items on the prop tables.
- Drinks backstage are to be in plastic containers.
- Do not eat or drink food props, unless onstage and scripted to do so.
- Please avoid eating and drinking in costume.
- Do not move and/or change the light and sound settings during tech week or the run of a show.
- Take care of all SPHS equipment and borrowed equipment. Do not use equipment until you have been instructed on how to use it.
- Wear appropriate safety gear when operating power tools and equipment at all times. (i.e., safety glasses, earplugs, gloves, ect.)
- Only cast, running crew, and theatre staff are allowed onstage, backstage, in the balcony, and booth before and during any performances.

Blatant disregard of any of these codes of conduct or policies can/may jeopardize your membership in the troupe.
