

Individual Competition Licensing Guidelines

Teachers and students are responsible for securing licenses for monologues and songs entered into the Individual Competition. Please use the information below to guide you as you secure these rights. Competitors must be able to produce a hard copy proof of the rights when submitting their students videos for Round One of adjudication.

****If your piece(s) is not from these four houses, you must reach out to the publishing house for directions/permission to perform your piece.

****These are still being updated! Once students have chosen their pieces, check this document to make sure all eligibility requirements have been met.

- Playscripts: Performances fall under "License Exemption", so no permissions are needed!
- Concord: Most are fine without permission. Check the "no-go" list using the following link: https://schooltheatre-my.sharepoint.com/:x:/g/personal/eyoung_schooltheatre_org/E_Wi-HBFHJfJLhqk3cKd5UkQB7AsI7b6v_u8WoNtQ4KUIIg?rtime=loznsO-f20g
- MTI: Each school should sign an individual rights agreement for any songs or monologues from titles MTI licenses. There is no associated charge, so you do not need to fill out the payment sections. When registering students in the **Individual Registration form**, teachers will have to list the title of the piece, the playwright and the publishing house. **For MTI and Dramatic Publishing**, **teachers will have to upload proof of rights to perform**.
