Classroom Theatre Activities	
Take a theatre class at SPHS	5 points (per class)
Participate in workshop	1 point (per workshop)
Attend a theatre festival/competition	1 point (per day)
Watch a live theatre performance	.25 points (per performance)
Participate in a theatre competition	2 points = per/individual event 5 points = per/show
Enter a playwriting contest	4 points = per/one act 8 points = per/full length
Attend a theatre field trip (non-competition)	1 point (per day)
Attend drama club/officer meeting	.1 points (per meeting)
Clean Up Day	1 point (per day)
Class time set building/painting/cleaning	1 point (per day)
Awards Show/Assembly Participation	1 point (per performance)

Outreach Activities	
Participate in theatre fundraisers	1 point (per day of fundraiser)
Perform at a community venue (indoor or outdoor), such as an elementary school, playground, public library, or park	1 point (per performance)
Raise \$500 for a Thespian Relief Grant to fund troupe dues and induction fees for a troupe in need	1 point (per 10 hours of volunteer work)

Advocacy Activities	
Create a presentation or letter, and attend and advocate for theatre education at a school board meeting	1 point (per 10 hours of advocacy work)
Participate in TIOS activities to promote theatre education in the school and community	1 point (per 10 hours of advocacy work)
Prepare for and participate in a virtual meeting with a local, state, or federal elected official	1 point (per 10 hours of advocacy work)

Service Activities	
Serve as a troupe officer – President	9 points
Serve as a troupe officer – Vice President	8 points
Serve as a troupe officer/cabinet – All Others	5 points
Serve as a Student/Provincial Thespian Officer for your chapter	8 points
Organize or participate in troupe fundraising	1 point (per 10 hours of volunteer work)
Mentor a newer Thespian about attending chapter festivals or the International Thespian Festival	1 point (per 10 hours of mentoring)

Record a tutorial on a tech theatre skill	1 point = 10 hours of prep and presentation
Write, perform, and record an original song/monologue	.5 points
Perform in an “open mic”	.5 points
Stage manage an “open mic”	1 point
Perform in a cabaret	1 point

Leading Role	4 points = One Act 8 points = Full Length
Supporting Role	3 points = One Act 5 points = Full Length
Ensemble Member	2 points = One Act 5 points = Full Length
Stage Manager/ASM	4 points = One Act 8 points = Full Length
Student Director	5 points = One Act 9 points = Full Length
Lighting Designer Set Designer Costume Designer Props Designer	4 points = One Act 7 points = Full Length
House Manager/Usher	1 point
Develop a hypothetical design plot	.5 points per design
Participate in tech crew	2 points = One Act 5 points = Full Length

Thespian Pin and Ribbon System

Thespian Points Earned	Honor Item and Signification
10	Thespian Induction Pin <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official Thespian induction earned • Induction pin = first point star earned = 1-star Thespian
20	1st Thespian Point Star is attached to the Thespian Honors Ribbon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Induction Pin (10 points) + 1 Point Star (10 additional points) = 20 Points = 2-star Thespian
30	2nd Thespian Point Star attached to Thespian Honors Ribbon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Induction Pin (10 points) + 2 Point Stars (20 additional points) = 30 points = 3-star Thespian
40	3rd Thespian Point Star attached to Thespian Honors Ribbon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Induction Pin (10 points) + 3 Point Stars (30 additional points) = 40 points = 4-star Thespian
50	4th Thespian Point Star attached to Thespian Honors Ribbon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50 points = 5-star Thespian
60	Honor Thespian Pin attached to Thespian Honors Ribbon <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All stars removed from ribbon • 60 points = Honor Thespian Rank = 6-star Thespian
70-110	One Thespian Point Star attached to Thespian Honors Ribbon for each additional 10 points earned in addition to Honor Thespian Pin. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 70-110 points = 7- to 11-star Honor Thespian
120	National Honor Thespian Pin replaces Honor Thespian Pin <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All stars removed from ribbon • 120 points = National Honor Thespian Rank = 12-star Thespian
130-170	One Thespian Point Star attached to Thespian Honors Ribbon for each additional 10 points earned in addition to National Honor Thespian Pin <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 130-170 points = 13- to 17-star Thespian
180	International Honor Thespian Pin replaces National Honor Thespian Pin <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highest ITS rank attainable • All stars removed from ribbon • 180 points = International Honor Thespian = 18-star Thespian
